Regional Meet Schedule: It is our goal to have the schedule out no later than two weeks prior to regionals, pending score verifications and schedule approval from Regional Committee.

Meet Registration and Entry Procedure:

- 1. Level 6 and Xcel will have an online and a paper regional meet entry upon completion of your state meet
- 2. The paper entry form and all payment are due the last day of your state meet
- 3. Online registration is through USA Gymnastics. You MUST have a USA Gymnastics Username, Password and MUST BE A DESIGNATED CLUB ADMINISTRATOR.
- 4. Make sure to double-check the accuracy of your USA Gymnastics club athlete roster for correct spelling of names, date of birth and level of athlete.
- 5. Step by Step procedure for Online Registration:
- 6. How to Register:
 - a. Login to www.usagym.org
 - b. Click on Member Services (top right)
 - c. Click on Club Administrators (left navigation)
 - d. Scroll down menu Click on Meet Reservations
 - e. Click Search for Meets (bottom right)
 - f. Select Discipline (Women's), State (IL)
 - g. Select Meet you want to enter (Name: Level 6 and Xcel Silver Regionals Sanction#: 78760) (Name: Region 5 Xcel Gold, Platinum & Diamond Championships - Sanction#: 78821)

- h. Place a check mark next to qualified gymnasts. NO PETITIONS for Level 6 or Xcel gymnasts
- i. Check mark next to attending coaches
 - i. ALL attending coaches MUST be registered through USA Gymnastics Online Meet Registration to coach and be served food
- j. Click Submit
- k. Both yourself and the meet director will receive an email with your entry
- 7. Complete Hard Copy Return registration form and fee to your State Chair or designated person after the state meet.

MeetRegistrationandEntryProcedure: Coaches

Coaches must register for the regional competition online and by hard copy at their state meet. Anychanges (additions and/or deletions) should be sent to the appropriate meet director.

***We ask that you bring the MINIMUM number of coaches for the number of athletes you have competing. We understand that many clubs have different event coaches, however if possible we ask for a maximum of 2 coaches per team per session to minimize the people in the competition area. ONLY credentialed coaches will receive hospitality.

COVID Safety Protocols - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!

- COVID Safety Protocols may change depending on local and/or state regulations.
- Please do not ENTER Gym EARLY!! No athletes, spectators or coaches will be allowed into the venue until the
 ARRIVAL TIME for each session. We need time to get the preceding group out of building, disinfect high
 touched areas and then open entry for the next session.
- Spectators will be LIMITIED per competing athlete (exact number TBA) inside the building for each session. Any siblings competing in subsequent sessions will be counted as spectators. This will be enforced!
 - When entering facility, ALL spectators will go through a small COVID questionnaire procedure.
 - Allspectators, volunteers, judges and coaches are required to wear a mask ATALLTIMES.
 By attending this Regional Meet ALL participants and spectators agree to the mask protocol. Gymnastics, as a community, has worked hard at getting in person meets this year so please be kind and follow the mask wearing at all times while in the facility.

No eating will be allowed in the competition area.

- Athletes will be required to wear a mask with the exception of while performing on equipment
- We ask that you bring the MINIMUM number of coaches for the number of athletes you have competing. We understand that many clubs have different event coaches, however if possible we ask for a maximum of 2 coaches per team per session to minimize the people in the competition area.
 - Open stretch will occur on the matting of your first event.
- Gymnasts, coaches and spectators will be asked to socially distance themselves from others.
 Bleachers/benches for seating will be marked. Otherwise, the responsibility falls to the individual to assist in this effort. PLEASE socially distance from other so we do not have to police everyone!
 - There will be no formal march in, just an announcement of teams at each event.
- Awards will occur directly on the competition floors immediately following the competition. Athletes can sit
 socially distanced around the edges of the floor. The places will be thoroughly spread out on the floor, with
 each placement at least 6' apart. For team awards, your masked entire team may accept together or you may
 send up one athlete/coach, based on the comfort level of your team.
- Hospitality for coaches will be offered with lunch/dinner served dependent on session times. Packaged snacks and drinks will also be available at all times. Hospitality will feature either individually packaged meals or meals served by a designated hospitality staff. No open buffet items will be offered.
